An International Fair at the Carnegie Rooms, organised by Keystone Development Trust, saw over a thousand visitors on Sunday September 24th.

Organised as part of the Breckland European Learning Festival, the International Fair brought over a thousand people from different backgrounds to the Carnegie rooms where they experienced a day of learning and fun. The fair combined crafts, activities for children, music, dance and delicious food from around the world. Amongst the performers there was a Lithuanian dance group, Irish dancers, children from Olivia's Piano School, young Portuguese performers and a Polish Break-dance duo.

"It was incredible to see all the communities dancing together when the Lithuanian dance group taught the audience a traditional dance," said Sandra, Equalities Volunteer at Keystone Development Trust. "This was exactly the aim of this Fair and I believe people will be talking about this day for a long time."

The European Learning Festival is being organised as part of the Breckland New Communities Project, managed by Keystone Development Trust while working in close partnership with Breckland Council and Norfolk County Council Adult Education Service.
